

CITES news - Prague airport



Czech Environmental Inspectorate



Czech citizen coming back from his family holiday in Mauritius via Charles de Gaulle Airport, France, was checked on his arrival at Prague Airport by the routine customs control at 30th January 2007. His luggage contained 19 specimens of different species of order *Scleractinia*, size 4 to 22 cm. He explained that he collected them on the beach next to his hotel in Trou Deux Douce, Mauritius. Corrals were confiscated and a fine was imposed by Czech Environmental Inspectorate.
