

CITES news - Prague airport

25. 3. 2010 – Customs officers at the Prague airport with the cooperation of CEI inspectors checked a luggage of a Vietnamese arriving from Hanoi and found two little packets wrapped in newspaper, each of them about 100 g. After questioning the importer the original suspicion of an animal origin was confirmed. The importer stated that the packets contained dry home – made preparation from monkeys and were intended for healing of a broken leg. The packets were seized and the importer will be fined.
