

CITES news - Prague airport

17.1.2007 – Czech citizen coming back from Mali had one head and two skins of African Savanna Monitor (*Varanus exanthematicus*, CITES II/B), skin of African Python (*Python sebae*, CITES II/B), two dried up Straw-coloured Fruit Bats (*Eidolon helvum*, nonCITES), two dried up heads and one hand of Olive Baboon (*Papio anubis*, CITES II/B), shell of African Helmeted Turtle (*Pelomedusa subrufa*, CITES III/C Ghana), dried up head of Honey Badger (*Mellivora capensis*, CITES III/C Botswana, Ghana) and 164 spines of Crested Porcupine (*Hystrix cristata*, CITES III/A Ghana) in his luggage. All CITES specimens were seized and this citizen will be fined because he did not have any permits to import specimens legally.
